

Voting for the February 2nd Republican Primary

You have several options, thus there is no reason not to VOTE REPUBLICAN

Grace Period Voting – only at the Henry County Clerk's office (M-F/8 am – 4:30 pm) until Tuesday, Jan 26th. You can register and vote if you are not registered or need to update your voter registration.

Early Voting – in person at Henry County Clerk or most City Clerk's Office until Thursday, Jan 28th. You must reside within the city limits to vote at your city clerk's office. State law requires you to present a valid photo ID in order to early vote.

Absentee Voting – Illinois law permits a person to request and vote an absentee ballot without specifying a reason. You may mail application to clerk or complete application and vote at the County Clerk's office. Mailed applications must be received by Jan 28th. In person absentee voting at the County Clerk until Monday, Feb 1st. The County Clerk's Office will be open on Saturday, Jan 30th 8 am – noon for in person absentee voting.
